### Seeds and the Mail

"As of Nov. 1, Ball Seed, Ball Superior and ColorLink are shipping seed orders in N. America by Federal Express. The switch to FedEx was based on the recent U.S. Postal Service decision to use electron-beam devices to sanitize letters and packages. By using FedEx the seed will not be exposed to any irradiation or sterilization system. Growers will now be able to track their seed orders online through the FedEx tracking system (<http://www.FedEx.com>). Growers can also request that their orders beshipped by UPS from Ball's West Chicago distribution center. A spokesperson for USPS said the agency is aware that certain things are affected by irradiation (including plants) and is working on a process to separate mail that would be affected. It will start installing some irradiation machinery this month. <a href="http://">http://</a> w w w . b a l l s e e d . c o m >

These concerns are shared by many mail-order nurseries. It appears the amount of radiation needed to kill anthrax spores would be sufficient to kill seeds and possibly live plants. Many companies that have relied on the U.S. mail are considering changing to an alternate carrier. USPS Spokesman Jerry Kreienkamp confirms that the USPS is working on a solution to this problem.

Contact the post office nearest you for further information, but don't be surprised if they aren't aware of any of this.

### Yummy Recipes

Ah!! Winter's here and we're freezing! Remember Summer? Remember the wonderful warm day of the DVOS BBQ? Remember I said I'd share recipes? Well here's one! (more next month) - Kathy Barrett

Madge Fordyce's Creamed Corn

Known far and wide as Frank's favorite dish! He likes the creamed corn, too.

16oz. frozen whole kernel corn (I use petite corn)
8 oz. whipping cream
8 oz. milk
1 tsp salt
1/4 tsp Accent (optional)
6 tsp sugar
pinch white or cayenne pepper
2 Tbsp. butter
2 Tbsp. flour

Combine all ingredients except last 2 in a pot and bring to a boil. Simmer 5 minutes. Blend melted butter with flour, add to the corn mixture and stir well. Remove from fire.

VARIATION: Put finished corn in an oven proof cassarole, sprinkle with

parmesan cheese and place under a broiler till evenly browned. Serves 8.
