

This nation and the rest of the world was focused on the impending inauguration of our 44th president. If the subject matter didn't have the word Obama in the title nobody was interested- except at the last DVOS meeting, where the focus was on Good Plants, Bad Plants. For one hour, our own gifted speakers, Dennis Olivas and Kathy Barrett, entertained and informed the crowd with their vast knowledge.

So what did the crowd in attendance see? Almost all the plants considered "bad" were just culturally challenged.

Leaves that showed sunburn, had too much sun. A mounted dried out Bulbolphyllum needed more humidity. Some Cymbidiums

and Zygopedelums were dropping their leaves, which is normal when winter arrives and the weather gets cold and wet. The cold and damp weather will also will cause Dendrobiums to drop their leaves.

This is why you need to cut back on the water during the winter months. When the Dendrobiums start to get their new leaves and shoots, then it's time to water and fertilize to encourage new blooms.

Many of the orchids had yellow leaves. This is normal in the cold winter months and can be fixed by turning up the heat in the greenhouse. Many orchids brought in had spots on the leaves. The Phalaenopsis had soft spots and the Cymbidiums had black spots. Both of these problems are caused by cold, damp conditions. These conditions promote bacteria and fungal spores to propagate. If the spots smell, then they are most likely bacterial in origin.

The cure for both fungal and bacterial spots is to pour hydrogen peroxide directly on the spot or to sprinkle cinnamon on the spot. One other treatment is to mist the plant with Lysol spray, which will kill bacteria and fungal infections.

Yellow spots on the leaves are usually caused by spider mites. They can be controlled by increasing the humidity or by spraying the plant with Rosecare.

Thank you Dennis and Kathy. Now back to the presidential inauguration.


